Assembly Sheweth

That your Petitioner is a friend of ^{Isabella} Catherine McDonald of the Township of Oxford (Western Division) in the County of Oxford a daughter of the late Archibald McDonald late of the Township of Daughan in the County of York, Michigan deceased and Catherine McDonald formerly of the said Township of Daughan late of the said Township of Blanchard deceased.

That the said Archibald McDonald died at Daughan aforesaid on or about the first day of September in the year of our Lord 1834 without having appointed any guardian for his said daughter, and without having made any last will and testament.
