Know all Men by these Presents that
I Margaret McKay of the Town of Woodville
in the District of Brock and Province of Cana
Widow am hold and firmly bound unto
Sir Richard Dennis Jackson Knight Commander of the Most Honourable
Military and of the Bath Administration of the Government of the Province
of Canada and his Successor in the Government of said Province
of Canada in the Penal Sum of Three hundred Pounds of good
and lawful Money of the said Province to be paid to the said Sir
Richard Dennis Jackson or his Successors as aforesaid, for
which payment to be well and faithfully made, I bind
myself and my heirs Executors and Administrators
-tors firmly by these Presents. Sealed with my
Seal and dated this twenty eighth day of
October in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and Forty one

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the within
and above bounden Margaret McKay Administratrix of all and
Singular the goods Chattels and Credits of Samuel McKay late of
Woodville aforesaid should or should be
made a true and perfect Inventory of all and Singular the goods
Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come
into the hands possession or Knowledge of her the said Margaret
McKay or into the hands and possession of any other person or
persons for her and the same to made do exhibit or Cause
to be exhibited into the Registry of the Surrogate Court of the
said District on or before the twenty seventh day of October
next ensuing the date hereof and the same goods Chattels
and Credits and all other the goods Chattels and Credits of
the said deceased at the time of his Death which at any time

after shall come into the hands or possession of the said Margaret
McKay or into the hands or possession of any other person or
persons, for her do well and truly administer according to
Law. and further do make or cause to be made a true and
just account of her said administration at or before the
Twenty seventh day of October next ensuing, and all the
Rest and Residue of the said goods Chattels and Credits which
shall be found remaining upon the said Administrators
account, the same being first examined and allowed by
the Judge of the Court for the time being, shall deliver and
pay unto such person or persons respectively, as the said
Judge, by his decree or Sentence conformable to the provisions
in a certain Act of Parliament, Intituled, "An Act for the
better settling intestate Estates" and passed in the Twenty
second and twenty third Year of the Reign of Charles
the Second. and also in a certain Act passed in the
sixt year of King James the Second, contained, shall
commit and appoint, and if it shall hereafter
appear, that any last will or Testament was made by
the deceased, and the Decutor or Executor therein named
do exhibit the same into the said Court making Request
to have it allowed and approved accordingly. If the
said Margaret McKay, within her said being therein
required do tender and deliver the said Letters of
Administration (approbation of such Testament being first
had and made,) in the said Court, then the obligation to
be void and of none effect, or else to remain of full force and
Virtue.
