UNDER the authority of an Order in Council of the *Second* day of *May* 1833 granting unto *John M. Kenzie* of the Township of *York* District *Carpenter* in the *Home* Acres of Land, as a discharged *Sergeant* from the *79th* Regiment, free of fees

I do hereby assign to the said *John M. Kenzie* Lot *N^o Three* in the *Tenth* Commission

in the Township of *Blondford* in the County of *Oxford* in the *London* District containing *Two hundred* Acres, subject to the Conditions of actual residence, and cultivation of the Land, for three years: at the expiration of which, upon filing a Certificate of the above condition having been fulfilled, a Patent will issue, free of expense.
