from Ireland some years ago That his Father
and friends resided in the Township of Berford
where your Petitioner immediately repaired
That after remaining amongst them for some
time your Petitioner learned that Lot No 7 in
2^d Con of Blenheim a Clergy Reserve was vacant
and as the Lot was situated in the vicinity of
his friends he was anxious to obtain it your
Petitioner made an application accordingly in
December 1834 for a Lease of it but was told
that Leases were not at that time granted
for Clergy Reserves though it was not impro-
bable he might hereafter obtain one In this hope
your Petitioner commenced his improvements and
has a house built and a considerable clearing
on the Lot your Petitioner has no other land
and as he has a large family and is at present
unable to purchase he humbly prays your
Excellency that a Lease of this Lot may be
granted to him on his paying the Rent from
the time he first occupied it
