Know All Men by these presents that We Adbel Eddy of the Township of Burford Yeoman John Eddy of the Township of Oakland Esquire and Paul Moore of the Township of Burford Yeoman all in the District of Brock are jointly and severally held and firmly bound to Matthias Moore of the aforesaid Township of Burford Infant son of the late John Moore late of the said Township of Burford and of Phoebe Moore his Wife in the sum of Five Hundred Pounds of lawful Money of Canada to be paid to the said Matthias Moore or his certain Attorney Executors, Administrators or Assigns. For which payment to be well and truly made We Bind Ourselves Our and each of our Heirs Executors and Administrators firmly by these presents

Sealed with our seals. Dated this eleventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine.

Whereas the above named and bounded Adbel Eddy having been this day appointed Guardian to the above named Infant son of the late John Moore late of the Township of Burford deceased by William Laperriere Esquire Judge of the Singsat Court of the District of Brock the said Adbel Eddy hath agreed as such Guardian as aforesaid to enter into the Securities required by law for the due performance of his duties as such Guardian as aforesaid and hath named the above bounded John Eddy and Paul Moore Securities for the due fulfilment of such duties.

Now the Condition of this Bond or Obligation is such that if Adbel Eddy shall and do faithfully perform the said Office of Guardian and if the said Adbel Eddy his Executors or Administrators shall and do when and as the said Matthias Moore shall become of full age of twenty one years, or whenever the said Guardianship shall be determined or sooner if thereunto required by the Judge of the said Court render to the said Matthias Moore or to his Executors or Administrators a true and just Account of all Goods, Monies, Rents, Profits or Property of him the said Matthias Moore which shall come into the hands of the said Adbel Eddy and shall and do thereupon deliver and pay over to the said Matthias Moore or to his Executors or Administrators the Property or the Sum or Balance of Money which may be in the hands of the said Adbel Eddy belonging to the said Matthias Moore, only deducting therefrom and retaining a reasonable Sum for the Expenses and Charges of the said Adbel Eddy. Then and in that Case the abovescribed Bond or Obligation shall be null and void.
