That your Petitioner has been in the  
 Province three years, and has a family -  
 that he was originally returned by Mr Thomas  
 Ingersoll the late Receiver of Oxford for Lot 18 in  
 the 1<sup>st</sup> Con: taken front. in 1<sup>st</sup> Township, containing  
 about 280 acres; but that afterwards Mr Ingersoll  
 recommended a Mr. Stanger relating to 18 in the  
 1<sup>st</sup> Con: to your Petitioner's great detriment -  
 that there is not any improvement on the 1<sup>st</sup> Lot 18 -  
 1<sup>st</sup> Con: except about 2 acres cut down. Mr Stanger  
 has been in the U. States, for twelve months last past -  
 & it is said does not intend to return. Your Petitioner  
 therefore humbly prays your Excellency for a part of  
 the Lot 18 in the 1<sup>st</sup> Con: or so much thereof as will  
 make your Petitioner's complement 200 acres, & as it
