Acres Nine in the fourth Concession bearing Date the first Day
of May in the year 1817 & that the Rent of the same
be accepted yearly for the term of years I should your Petitioner prayer
be favourably answered he is ready by his Agent Peter Seave
of said Town to pay the Rent in arrears from the afore-
said proposed Date as required by the Regulations of the
1st of April 1811 - And your Petitioner as
in duty bound will ever pray
