Sheweth

That Lot N^o 23 in the 9th Concession of
the Township of Norwich, in the District of
London, was purchased by your Petitioner at a
Sale of Forfeited Estates on the 17th of November
1828, and Decided to him by the Commissioners
of Forfeited Estates on the 25th of January 1829,
as appears by the Deed hereunto.

That the sum of £4-0-10³/₄, Amey,
being demanded as Taxes & Cost, due and
payable on said Lot up to July 1829,
has been paid by your Petitioner, through
his Brother and another Person, as ap-
pears by the annexed Receipt from the
Sheriff, in order to prevent its being
sold. That your Petitioner was not before
aware that the Lot had been advertised
for Sale for Taxes, and conceived that
no Tax would be payable before the date
of his Deed, the Lot being the Property

payment from the Treasurer, having
been informed by Mr. Amasa Wilson, your
Petitioner's Uncle, and who is under similar
circumstances with your Petitioner, that he
requires to be first authorized by your
Excellency in Council.

Therefore your Petitioner humbly
prays your Excellency will be pleased
to order the Treasurer to return to your
Petitioner such amount as may be
found to have been overpaid to the
Treasurer by your Petitioner on the
said Lot.
