Grimsby 6<sup>th</sup> August 1828.

Sir,

As respects my deed for my lands in the Town-  
ship of Blandford, I have to say, that the man who  
made the Improvement, Wm. Lee, late of the Town-  
-ship of Oxford, London District, sold his improvements  
on Lot No 18 - a Concession of said Township of Blandford  
to Henry Lambert for £15 - and more than two thirds of  
the Improvement is on the Government Reserve - and  
I have now agreed with Lambert to cultivate the Land until  
he is fully paid - Lambert also agreed that he would  
clear and fence 8 or 10 acres, if I would let him  
have it for five years, which I agreed to, I assure you  
what I have stated is correct, I can also say that there  
are large Improvements made and making on the  
Government Reserve, and selling from one to another,  
this is continually the case, as I am informed, and  
that I am knowing to myself

Sir,

As respects my debt for my Lands  
 in the Township of Blandford, I have to say, that  
 the Man who made the Improvement, Uliak Tree  
 late of the Township of Oxford, London District,  
 sold his improvement on Lot No 18 - 1<sup>st</sup> Concess<sup>n</sup> of  
 said Township of Blandford, to Henry Lambert  
 for £15 - and since then two thirds of the Improvement  
 is in the Government Reserve, - and I have now  
 agreed with Lambert to cultivate the Land until  
 he is fully paid - Lambert also agreed that he  
 would clear and fence 8 or 10 Acre, if I would  
 let him have it for five years, which I agreed to.  
 I assure you what I have stated is correct, I can  
 also say that there are large Improvements made  
 and making in the Government Reserve, and  
 selling from one to another, this is continually  
 the case, as I am informed, and part I am  
 knowing to myself.
