Whereas my husband the late Joshua Northrup of the Township of Durham in the said District and Province died on the 27th of September 1830, and administration to his goods and Chattels Rights and Credits rightly belongs to me the said Amy Northrup his Widow, and being unwilling to undertake the burden thereof from inexperience in matters of business, do hereby Renounce all my right and claim to such administration in favor and in behalf of Ely Harris of the Township of Oxford West in said District and Province Given under my hand at Woodstock this twenty eighth day June 1861 —

that I Ely Harris of the Township of Oxford West in the

I am and being bound to the Right
Honorable Charles Baron Sydenham Governor
General of the Province of Canada and his
Successors in the penal sum of three hundred
Pounds of good and lawful money of the Pro-
vince of Canada to be paid to the said Right
Honorable Charles Baron Sydenham or his
Successors, for which payment to be well and
faithfully made. I bind myself and my heirs &
Executors and administrators firmly by these
Presents sealed with my Seal. Dated this 28th
day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and forty one.

The Condition of this Obligation is that if the
within mentioned Ely Harris administrator fall and
Singular the goods chattels and Credits of Joshua
Northrup deceased, do make or cause to be made
a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the
goods chattels and Credits of the said deceased, which
have or shall come into the hands possession or
Knowledge of him the said Ely Harris or into the
hands and Possession of any other person or
persons

Persons for him, and the same so made, do exhibit or
Cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Surrogate
Court of the said District on or before the twenty eighth
day of June next ensuing the date of these Presents.
And the same goods Chattels and Credits, and all
other the goods Chattels and Credits of the said
deceased at the time of his death, which at any
time after shall come into the hands or possession
of the said Ely Harris, or into the hands or possession
of any other person or persons for him, do well
and truly administer according to Law, and further
do make or Cause to be made, a true and just
account of his said administration at or before
the twenty eighth day of June next ensuing.
And all the rest and residue of the said goods
Chattels and Credits, which shall be found remain-
ing upon the said Administration account
the same being first examined and allowed
by the Judge of the Court, for the time being,
shall deliver and pay unto such person or
persons respectively, as the said Judge, by his
decree or Sentence Conformably to the Provisions
in a certain Act of Parliament, intituled
"An Act for the better settling intestate Estates";
and passed in the twenty second and twenty
third year of the Reign of Charles the Second
and also in a certain Act passed in the
first year of King James the Second, contained
shall limit and appoint, and if it
shall

shall hereafter appear. That any last will or Testament
was made by the deceased, and the Executor or Executors
therein named do exhibit the same unto the Said
Court, making Request to have it allowed & approved
accordingly. If the said Ely Harris within bounds
being thereto required, do render and deliver
the said letters of Administration. (approbation
of such Testament being first had and made) in
the said Court. then this obligation to be void
and of none effect. or else to remain in full
force and virtue.
