5th Concession of this Township set apart in a Globe and
that the remainder may be secured in such a way as may
appear most advisable to your Excellency to assist your
Petitioners in the maintenance of a Clergyman who they hope
at no distant period, will be settled amongst them for
which favour as in duty bound your Petitioners shall
ever most gratefully pray.
