My dad is J. (James) Ross Rothaermel. His folks were Christina Catherine Murray Rothaermel and John Klein Rothaermel. Grandma Christina grew up in on a farm located near Embro. John Klein was raised in New Hope outside Berlin/Waterloo, little east of you.

Great Grandma Betsy Murray and William Murray arrived in Stratford Ontario Canada in 1840. They built a stone house on land they purchased from the Canada Co. in 1845. They purchased a farm/land in West Zorra Township, Oxford Co. Ontario, Canada. Lot #33 Concession G. 150 acres on May 28, 1842. (In the family from 1842-1906). William and Betsy had 10 children. William died in 1912 age 92. Betsy died in 1906 she was 90 years old. The stone house (picture enclosed) they built is still standing on the acreage they purchased way back when. My dad attended Maple Wood School. Gram and Grandpa Murray moved into Embro in their later years. They are buried in a cemetery there. (picture enclose.)

I am sending you these family pictures as I believe they might be of interest to you. Also a book about the Zorra boys. I have another book about Zorra which I am keeping for now but may send later.

Christina Murray Rothaermel

Christina Murray was born in West Zorra Township, Oxford County, Canada on February 29, 1860, leap year. She was the youngest child of Betsy and William Murray.

Christina was born in the stone house on the farm William purchased in the Maplewood area from the German Company in 1845. Christina attended Maplewood School, as would all her children. Christina married John Klein Rothaermel. on May 26, 1881.

John Klein Rothaermel's mother arrived in 1827 and his father in 1840c. from Germany and farmed around the Berlin, Waterloo area. The family farm was in Lisbon outside Wellesley, and the family attended the Swedenborgian Church. John spoke German in the family home.

In 1896 Christina and John purchased the Stone House farm from William and Betsy. Most of their children were born there. The family lived on the farm until 1904 when the farm was sold, and the family moved to Cleveland, Ohio, USA. (John's asthma had improved on a previous business trip to the Cleveland area.)

In East Cleveland, OH, the family lived on Breezy Hill farm. The family lived there until around 1913 when they moved into a house in East Cleveland at 1684 Elberon Ave. They lived in this house until their deaths.

Christina and John had 10 children, four boys and six girls. One son, Emanuel, died at two days and is buried in the Harrington Cemetery in Canada. The rest of the children stayed in the Cleveland area and raised their families. Their children followed many vocations: banker, butcher, farmer, seamstress, fireman, executive, tavern owner and entrepreneur. Many served their country in WWI and II. One great grandson gave his life while serving in Vietnam.

Christina and John made many trips back to Canada to visit the Rothaermels and Murrays. Many trips were taken to visit the Iowa families and they remained close until their deaths. Our hundreds of pictures are a tribute to this family and read like a history lesson.

John died in 1920 and Christina stayed in the house with her unwed daughters until her death in 1932.

My knowledge of the history of the state of Hesse-Darmstadt is not very good. A few years ago a fried asked me for help with her genealogy of the Rothämel (Rothaemel) family which lived in Melsungen and Schmalkalden in Hesse-Kassel. In this connection I also did some research on the Rothermels (Rothaermel) families, mostly just to see if I could find any connection, which I did not. All the Rothermels that I found lived in Hessen-Darmstadt. Since that is not my area of research I did not pursue the research further, but in my notes I have found a reference in our magazine which may interest you as well as a letter from a Rothermel researcher which certainly will.

Both are in German. Here are quick translations!

A Rothermel coat of arms (Page 60 in the Hessische Wappenrolle, Hessische Familienkunde, Vol. 10) was registered by Peter Wilhelm Rothermel, a farmer in the village of Haehnlein in Darmstadt Township.

The description of the coat of arms: Gold background with a black horseshoe above a bent arm that is wearing a red sleeve and holding a silver stick, symbol for a village mayor. Above the shield there is red and gold decoration and a red and gold roll (ring) holding an arm with a stick in horizontal position.

In a list of inhabitants in the County of Erbach in 1507 there is just one person called Rodyrmel who lived in Rimbach (in Township Bergstraße). He is the oldest known ancestor of this old farming family. The next oldest reference is in the village of Biebesheim, later the main centre of the family: Raups (Ruprecht) Rodtermel Senior, owner of a helmet and a lance, is mentioned 1588 in a draft list (for soldiers) together with Hans Rodtermel, presumably his son, armed with something to shoot with (bow and arrows, arquebus or gun?) and another Hans R. A complete family tree begins with the burial of Daniel Rothermel in Biebesheim, Jan. 2, 1673. He was a juryman and the church treasurer. His great-grandson, Joh. Adam R. (1714-72) was married in 1740 to Marie Elisabeth Rothermel, who was the daughter of the village mayor Nicolaus R. Joh. Adam was taken on as farmer of the estate belonging to the Chancellor Kilian von Schwarzenau in Hähnlein from which the family spread out widely, some as farmers on farms belonging to their descendants for generations, others beginning new lines in Darmstadt and Frankfurt. In 1966 there were 21 Rothermel families in Darmstadt. The first Rothermel seems to have come from Suebia, where 1283 a Conrad Rotermel is mentioned in Breisgau (area around Freiburg) and where today there are around 85 families with this name. Some went to Switzerland. The name is likely derived from the style of wearing garments with two colours, similarl to the names like Blauärmel, Weißärmel. The horseshoe in the coat of arms is a reference to Biebesheim which has a horseshoe in its coat of arms.

Hartmut Rothermels letter of 1998 to our society: He writes

Since I am fascinated by the history of my family (the first ancestor I know of is mentioned in 1283), I am establishing a worldwide computer Databank for the Rothermels.

It is intended to help all researchers find information about the family, making it easier to check material and prove its validity as well as gaining more.

Why should all information be researched many times unnecessarily and everything be typed up for computer use time after time?

I wish to establish a centre where all the known facts are collected and available for further research.

This material can be taken over with Gedkom into other systems and later used in Internet.

I need help from others to accomplish this. Maybe you have information already on our family. Please tell me your source and give me the names of other people who are looking for Rothermel information, have R. ancestors or are working on this line.

I would be very thankful for assistance. Please spread the news about my project and give my name and address to others. More information in our databank brings better possibilities to help others and better chances for gaining new insight.

At the moment my databank has information about the Biebesheim families, my direct line and collateral lines. By Email and letters I have received some information on lines in the USA, Hungary and Russia. Letters sent to Rothermels in Germany are bringing news about existing families (850 in Germany!) Contacts with the Rothermel-association in America are developing. My Databank is growing and already beginning to show results. Unfortunately many families have little knowledge of their past and so I am very happy for all sources of information profi-researchers can give me. Please help me with this project!

Kay Rothaermel Laughlin

Bay Village, Ohio born February 21, 1937 died July 25, 2020. daughter of the late J. Ross and Alberta Wurtz Rothaermel, wife of Gerald Lee Laughlin (married 62 years), adoring sister of Barbara Walker and Twin sister, Gay Menning (Dec), mother of Christopher (Connie), Kathy Ann and Thomas (Kelly), grandmother of Sara and Abigail.

Bay Village has lost its historian. No one knew more about Bay's history than Kay. She knew all the facts and people which she wove into stories. She had a remarkable memory that served her well all her life. Bay's history became her most enjoyable hobby. Kay lived in Bay Village all her life. A 1955 Bay High graduate, she received a Distinguished Alumni Award from Bay High School in 1978. Kay got her BS in Ed at The Ohio State University where she met her husband, Jerry. She was a member of the Alpha Delta Pi Sorority. Along with her sister, Gay, she wrote Bay Village, A Way Of Life in 1974, the first written history of the town. In 2007, Kay and Ginny Peterson compiled the picture book, Bay Village, collecting the pictures and writing the content. Kay joined the Bay Village Historical Society in 1968 and served as president for two years in 1976. She was part of the team that opened Rose Hill Museum in 1974. She was a docent for 20 years at Rose Hill Museum and became the society's historian. She was the manager of the historical society antique show, accessions chairman for 10 years, and one of the organizers at the Osborn Learning Center when the Osborn house was moved into Cahoon Park. For years she presented slide shows of Bay history, starting with the Lighted School House and the Reflections program at the Bay Middle School. Today Bay Village history is taught in the Bay Schools because of Kay and her sister. She was a past president of the Alpha Delta Pi West Cleveland Alumni Assoc., served on Normandy PTA for 10 years, and was the Bay United Methodist Church historian when they received an Ohio State historical marker. Kay was a great cook. She set a beautiful table. She loved to read and listen to music. She would say being on the water was her favorite place. She and Jer loved their boat and Kay was a great perch fisherman many times catching the most fish. She was an avid Cleveland sports fan, loving her Brownies. For 15 years she did tole painting and worked shows in the area. She took up watercolors, painting the family dogs, cats, and horses. She loved being outdoors and could name every flower and/or weed. She could tell you the artists and names of the songs her kids played in the 70s. There wasn't anything she couldn't do. She was the organizer and family tour guide. Her family meant everything to her. She loved Christmas and Thanksgiving dinner was her favorite meal which she loved to cook.

She will be missed.



SS 11 West Zorra, original Maplewood School. In 1862, a log school known as Innis's school was constructed on Lot 31 Concession 7, directly opposite the Maplewood store and situated on the north west corner of Road 96 & 45th Line, Zorra

SS 11 West Zorra, second Maplewood School, depicted on a postcard sent from the Maplewood post office, 1904 to Miss Bessie Rothaermel [Elizabeth Catherine Rothaermel Chandler, 1881-1946] in Cleveland, Ohio. In 1872, a half-acre of land was purchased from John Brown. A frame school was constructed by B. Young's of Stratford on Lot 30 Concession 7 next to the former general store [at the south west corner of Road 96 & 45th Line, Zorra. In the early days the school consisted of one large room, however in 1913 it was remodeled and a porch and basement were added.

SS 6 West Zorra, Youngsville School, depicted circa 1904. A special meeting of the rate payers was called on January 20th, 1866. The purpose of this meeting was to choose a site to erect a new School House. It was decided that a half acre of land be bought from John Youngs at Lot 21, east half of the 4th Concession. The contract for building the present red brick school was let to J. Campbell for \$1,050. The school was located at the north west corner of Road 88 & 37th Line Zorra.




