This is the last Will and Testament of me
Jane Chadwick of the Town of Ingersoll
in the County of Oxford and Province of
Ontario made this Twenty Seventh day
of December in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and eighty

I revoke all former Wills or other
Testamentary dispositions by me at
any time heretofore made and declare
this only to be and contain my last
Will and Testament.

I direct all my just debts funeral
and Testamentary expenses to be paid
and satisfied by my Executors hereinafter
named as soon as conveniently may be
after my decease.

I give devise and bequeath all my
real and personal estate of which I may
die possessed in the manner following
that is to say:

I give devise and bequeath to my
beloved husband Charles E. Chadwick
all the net interest and profits arising
from any real estate or personal property
of what nature or kind soever I may die
possessed of for his sole use and benefit
during his natural life save and except
the rent or interest arising from certain
property known as Town Lot Number
Four Block "E" West Side of Albert Street
in the Town of Ingersoll in the County of
Oxford and Province of Ontario the proceeds
of rent or interest derived from said land
and premises to be paid by my Executors
hereinafter named to my daughter Agnes
Jessie Chadwick as long as her father lives
or if she is unmarried at the time of her
father's decease until she marries, then
to be sold and the proceeds divided the same
as other property hereinafter named. If it
is considered by a majority of the hereinafter
mentioned legatees and Executors desirable
to sell the last mentioned property previous

to my husband's death they can name
+ the sum for the sale to take place

And my will further is that the interest
derived from funded credit stock owned
by me shall be paid over by my Executors
to Agnes Jessie Chadwick Solomons as she
keeps her father's house or takes care
of my two grand daughters Maud and
Mary Chadwick to be used for
needs of the household, in the event
her ceasing to take charge of her father's
house or my said grand children the
interest shall revert to her father unless
she is unmarried and loses her health
when she will retain it for her sole use
and benefit so long as she remains
unmarried and out of health. And my
will further is that at the decease of my
husband all my real estate and personal
property not hereinbefore or hereinafter
bequeathed shall be equally divided
by my Executors hereinafter named
between my daughters Mary M. Christopher
Agnes Jessie Chadwick and my sons Charles
Nathan Chadwick and William E. Chadwick
after having deducted Two Hundred
dollars to be paid in sums of One Hundred
each to Charles Nathan Chadwick and Agnes
Jessie Chadwick in lieu of sheep money
also the sum of Two Hundred dollars
to be paid to my Executors in sums of One
Hundred dollars each for their services
The amount of the share hereinbefore named
for my son William E. Chadwick to be
invested by my Executors and the interest
only to be paid to him during his lifetime
and at his decease the principal sum
shall revert and be divided between my
daughters Mary Christopher, Agnes E. Chadwick
and my son Charles Nathan Chadwick
I also give and bequeath at the decease
of my husband my plated sea set comprising
knit pieces and best cruet stand also my

best silk dress and one lace collar made
up to my daughter Mary M. Christopher and I
give and bequeath to my daughter Agnes S.
Chadwick all the rest and residue of my
clothing including my furs and garnet set
of jewelry the plated forks and spoons purchased
with my private means comprising two dozen
forks two sizes two dozen tea spoons one dozen
dessert spoons six table spoons
forks two salt spoons and all the same
after giving my daughter-in-law Emily
Margaret Chadwick one dozen coffee cups
and saucers and one dozen tea cups and
saucers one dozen dinner and one dozen
tea plates two medium sized platters and
two low cake plates all white, and I give
and bequeath at my husband's death
to be equally divided, to Jane M. Christopher
and Mary Jane Chadwick whatever plated
ware not hereinbefore bequeathed in
remembrance of their being named for me

And all the rest and residue of my
real and personal effects of what nature
or kind soever to be equally divided between
my two daughters Mary Christopher and Agnes
S. Chadwick and my son Charles Walter Chadwick

And I nominate and appoint Aaron
N. Christopher and Charles Walter Chadwick
to be executors of this my last will and testament
