received any Land or order for Land from the Crown
Wherefore your petitioner Humbly prays that your Excellency
will be pleased to grant him Two Hundred acres of waste
Lands of the Crown by an Order in Council for scrip
to the usual amount and your petitioner as in
Duty bound will ever pray
