I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the _____ date _____ under the authority of an Order in Council of the _____ by which he became entitled to a remission of £ _____ C'y the undermentioned Lots in the Township of _____ in the District of _____

The Conditions are as follows:—No Patent shall be permitted to issue until the expiration of two years, and until it shall be ascertained by the Surveyor General or by the Commissioner of Crown Lands, that the locatee or a resident settler has been established upon some part of the grant, who shall occupy and improve the same within six months from the date hereof, when the Patent will issue free of expence. The proof required that the above conditions are complied with, will be, the Certificate of a Deputy Surveyor, or of the Agent employed in settling the Townships.
