UNDER the authority of an Order in Council of the *5th* day of *September* 18*32* granting unto *Adam Ross* of the *Town* - of *York* in the *Home* - District *German* Soldier from the *42* - Regiment as a discharged Soldier free of fees

I do hereby assign to the said *Adam Ross* *The West parts of the Broken Lots. Eighth. Tenth. Eleventh. Twelfth. Fourteen & Fifteen in the Fourteenth Concession* in the Township of *St. Louis* in the County of *York* District of *London* containing *Five hundred* Acres, subject to the conditions of actual residence, and cultivation of the Land, for three years: at the expiration of which, upon filing a Certificate of the above condition having been fulfilled, a Patent will issue, free of expense. *The location in person to occupy & improve the land within six months of the date hereof.*
