The last Will and Testament of me Peter Sackrider of  
the Township of North Norwich Sixth Riding of the County of Oxford  
and Province of Canada West Farmer.

First I will and direct that all my just debts, funeral and testamentary  
expenses be paid as soon as conveniently may be after my decease.

Second. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Clarissa Sackrider  
the Homestead and farm upon which I now reside, being the East half  
of lot number Seven in the fifth Concession of the said Township of  
North Norwich (excepting two parts thereof hereinafter described and  
given to my two Sons Charles Sackrider and Cornwell Sackrider)  
for and during the term of her natural life. I also give and bequeath  
to my said wife the use and benefit of all such of my household goods  
and furniture as she may wish to retain for and during the term of  
her natural life. I further give and bequeath to my said wife  
one bed and bedding to her own sole use benefit and disposal

Third. After the decease of my said wife. I give devise and bequeath unto  
my two Grandsons Clissen Bingham Sackrider and John Albert  
Sackrider All and singular the above mentioned Homestead and farm  
(with the above named exceptions) containing Seventy two acres to the  
same more or less. To have and to hold (when they both shall have  
reached the age of twenty one) the same to them and their heirs and  
assigns for ever: But if either of my said Grandsons shall die  
before he shall arrive at the age of Twenty one. Then I give devise  
and bequeath the said Homestead and farm unto the survivor of  
my said two Grandsons and to his heirs and assigns for ever.  
(payed nevertheless in other case as hereinafter mentioned.)

Fourth. I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Charles Sackrider, two  
pieces or parcels of land parts of the said East half of the said lot number  
Seven in the said fifth Concession - the first piece containing eighteen  
square rods described as follows: Commencing in front of the said fifth  
Concession and in the centre of the said lot number Seven - Thence North  
 $78^{\circ} 30'$  East, seventy five links - Thence South  $11^{\circ} 30'$  East, one chain and  
fifty links - Thence South  $78^{\circ} 30'$  West, seventy five links to the centre  
of the said lot - Thence North  $11^{\circ} 30'$  West, one chain and fifty links to

the place of beginning. The second piece or parcel of land containing eight acres may be described and known as follows: Commencing in the rear of the said fifth concession and in the centre of the said lot number seven - Hence North  $11^{\circ} 30'$  West, along the centre of the said lot, sixteen chains; Hence North  $78^{\circ} 30'$  East, five chains; Hence South  $11^{\circ} 30'$  East, sixteen chains to the rear of the said concession; Hence South  $78^{\circ} 30'$  West, five chains to the place of beginning. To have and to hold the said two pieces or parcels of land containing together eight acres and eighteen rods as above described unto my said Son Charles Sackrider his heirs and assigns for ever. After the decease of my wife.

Fifth. - I give and bequeath to my Son Cornell Sackrider Twenty acres of the soil East half of the said lot number seven and to be the same more or less, and which may be described and known as follows: Commencing at a point on the centre line of the said lot number seven and which point is twenty chains distant from the rear of the said fifth concession - Hence North  $11^{\circ} 30'$  West, along the centre of the said lot, sixteen chains; Hence North  $78^{\circ} 30'$  East twelve chains seventy six and a half links more or less, to a line between lots numbers six and seven; Hence South  $11^{\circ} 30'$  East, sixteen chains; Hence South  $78^{\circ} 30'$  West, twelve chains seventy six and a half links, more or less to the place of beginning. Reserving the right of a Road or way on the East side of the above described land in the use of the parties occupying the land on the North and South sides of the said Twenty acres. To have and to hold the said Twenty acres with the said Reserve unto the said Cornell Sackrider his heirs and assigns for ever (after the decease of my wife)

Sixth. - I give and bequeath unto my Said Son Charles Sackrider the village of number five on the North side of Main Street, in the village of Merrimac - the same being part of lot number seven in the fourth concession of the said Township of Merrimac. To have and to hold the same to my said Son Charles Sackrider his heirs and assigns for ever.

I also give and bequeath to my said Son Charles Sackrider my left waggons and a set of single Harness.

Seventh. - I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Ann Dundas Fifty pounds to be paid to her within two years after my decease. I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Sarah Ann my silver spoons.

Eighth. - After the decease of my wife, I will and direct that all the said Goods and Household furniture which may have been retained by her for her

use, and left by her at her decease, shall be given to my said daughter Sarah Ann Dundas.

Ninth. I will and direct, that all the rest residue and remainder of my Stock, Estate and Effects not herein otherwise disposed of be sold by my Executors, and be disposed in their discretion for the purposes of this my will, and the balance to be given to my said wife.


Tenth. It is understood that my Sons Solomon and Christian have been provided for in my life time.
