The last Will and Testament of me Peter Sackrider of
the Township of North Norwich South Riding of the County of Oxford
and Province of Canada West Farmer.

First I will and direct, that all my just debts, funeral and testamentary
expenses be paid as soon as conveniently may be after my decease.

Second. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Clarissa Sackrider
the Homestead and Farm upon which I now reside, being the East half
of lot number Seven in the fifth Concession of the said Township of
North Norwich (excepting those parts thereof hereinafter described and
given to my two Sons Charles Sackrider and Edwin Sackrider)
for and during the term of her natural life. I also give and bequeath
to my said wife the use and benefit, of all such of my household goods
and furniture as she may wish to retain for and during the term of
her natural life. I further give and bequeath to my said wife
one bed and bedding to her own sole use benefit and disposal.

Third. After the decease of my said wife. I give devise and bequeath unto
my two Grandsons Elissen Bingham Sackrider and John Albert
Sackrider. All and singular the above mentioned Homestead and farm
(with the above named exceptions) containing Seventy two acres be the
same more or less. To have and to hold (when they both shall have
reached the age of twenty one) the same to them and their heirs and
assigns for ever. But if either of my said Grandsons shall die
before he shall arrive at the age of Twenty one. Then I give devise

Fifth. - I give ^{devise} and bequeath to my Son Cornell Sackrider Twenty acres ^{part} of the said East half of the said lot number seven - and to be the same more or less, and which may be described and known as follows: Commencing at a point in the centre line of the said lot number seven - and which point is twenty chains distant from the rear of the said fifth Concession - Thence North $11^{\circ}30'$ West, along the centre of the said lot, sixteen chains; Thence North $78^{\circ}30'$ East twelve chains seventy six and a half links more or less, to the line between lots numbers six and seven; Thence South $11^{\circ}30'$ East, sixteen chains; Thence South $78^{\circ}30'$ West, twelve chains seventy six and a half links, more or less to the place of beginning. Seventh. - I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Ann Durdas Fifty pounds to be paid to her within two years after my decease. I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Sarah Ann my silver spoons.

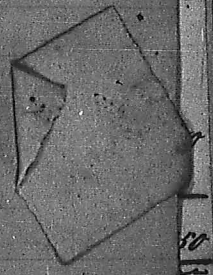
