The Petition of ^{now living in Oxford} ~~Mordecai~~ ^{by Appointment to the Council 31. 12. 1806} Sayles, has been in the Province 3 yrs and has received 200 acres of land, he has a wife and eight Children & having a promise from His Excellency for an additional 1000 Acres —
yr Petitioner married the Daughter of the late Ber^d Fairchild —

Respectfully shews,

THAT your petitioner is desirous to settle on the lands of the Crown in this Province, being in a condition to cultivate and improve the same. That he is ready to take the usual oaths, and to subscribe the declaration, that he professes the Christian Religion, and obedience to the laws, and has lived inoffensively in the country which he has left. Prays your Excellency, would be pleased to grant him ^{the} ~~the~~ ^{Thousand} — acres of land upon the terms and conditions expressed in your Excellency's proclamation bearing date the 7th day of February, 1792, or such other quantity of land as to your Excellency in your wisdom may think meet. And your petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray.
