Petition now lays in the Office of the Hon^{ble}. the Executive
Council, that it appears by the Plan of the Township of
Blenheim, in the Surveyor Gen^l's Office that Six Hundred Acres
are located in that Township for Her and in the hand
Writing of the Hon^{ble}. David William Smith, that your Petitioner's
Mother about Four years ago gave to Mr. John P. Olench
the authority for the above Six Hundred Acres, that he
might obtain the Deed for her, but that she has never
been able for want of that authority to procure it. Your
Petitioner therefore most humbly Prays your Excellency to take
her case into Consideration. And your Petitioner as in
