The Petition of Thomas Sherred of the Township of East Oxford in the County of Oxford Province the Sole Executor named in the last Will and Testament of Samuel Sherred late of the said Township Province deceased Humbly Sheweth

That Samuel Sherred late of the Township of East Oxford in the County of Oxford Province deceased duly made and published his last Will and Testament in Writing bearing date on or about the twenty eighth day of June in the year of our Lord 1858 and departed this life on or about the tenth day of July 1858 at the said Township without having in any way altered or revoked his said Will and thereby constituted and appointed your Petitioner Sole Executor of his said Will. That the said deceased at the time of his death was possessed of a well and sufficiently settled estate goods and chattels rights and credits all within the County aforesaid amounting in the whole to thirty pounds or thereabouts so far as your Petitioner has been enabled to ascertain. That he is desirous of proving the said Will Your Petitioner therefore humbly prays you would be pleased to appoint him to exhibit and prove the said Will And your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray

This Indenture witnesseth that I Samuel Sherris of the Township of East Oxford and County of Oxford and Province of Canada being of sound and disposing memory and understanding do make this publick and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and making null and void all former last Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made -

My will is first that my funeral charges and just debts shall be paid by my executors hereinafter named -

The residue of my Estate and property which shall not be required for the payment of my just debts, funeral charges and the expenses attending the execution of this my last Will and Testament and the administration of my Estate

I give and devise and dispose thereof as follows

To Mr. I give and bequeath to Alexander Sherris son of my Brother John Sherris the sum of one hundred dollars to be paid to him as soon as he becomes of age and I also bequeath to Sarah Ann Sherris the daughter of the afore said John Sherris, the sum of one hundred dollars to soon as she becomes of age -

I give devise and bequeath all the rest and remainder of my Estate real and personal and mixed

of which I shall be seized and possessed or
to which I shall be entitled at the time of
my decease to my Brother Thomas Sherrill
his heirs, Executors, administrators or assigns to his
and their use and behoof for ever and I do
nominate and appoint my Brother Thomas
Sherrill to be ^{the} sole Executor to this my last Will
and Testament in testimony whereof I the
said Samuel Sherrill have hereunto subscribed my
name and affixed my seal this twentyeighth day
of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty eight. Samuel Sherrill
