Canada Bachelor being of sound mind
though weak in body and wither a solemnance
of the uncertainty of life do hereby make and
declare this to be my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore
made

My will is that my Funeral charges and
expensed and just debts shall be paid by my
Executors herein after named

I give devise and bequeath all the real and resi-
-dual of my Estate and property real and personal
of which I shall be seized and possessed or to
-which I shall be entitled at the time of my
-decease to my beloved wife Martha Inarey to
hold the same to her, her heirs Executors Admin-
-istrators and assigns to her and their use and
behoof forever - and I do hereby nominate
and appoint my said wife Martha the sole
Executrix of this my last will and Testament.
