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PROVINCE OF CANADA.

Victoria, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, QUEEN, Defender of the Faith.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,—GREETING:

Whereas Aaron Springer, of the Township of North Norwich, in the County of York, hath contracted and agreed to and with Our Commissioner for the sale of Our Crown Lands, duly authorized by Us in this behalf, for the absolute purchase, at and for the price and sum of one hundred and ten dollars of lawful money of Our said Province, of the Lands and Tenements hereinafter mentioned and described, of which We are seized in right of Our Crown.

NOW KNOW YE, that in consideration of the said sum of one hundred and ten dollars by him the said Aaron Springer to Our said Commissioner of Crown Lands, in hand well and truly paid to Our use, at or before the sealing of these Our Letters Patent, We have granted, sold, aliened, conveyed and assured, and by these Presents do grant, sell, alien, convey and assure, unto the said Aaron Springer, his Heirs and Assigns for ever. ALL that Parcel or Tract of Land, situate, lying and being in the Township of North Norwich, in Our said Province, containing by admeasurement five acres in the County of York, by the same more or less; which said Parcel or Tract of Land may be otherwise known as follows, that is to say; being composed of Part of the south west quarter of Lot Number

sixteen, in the second concession, of the aforesaid Township of North Norwich, that is to say; commencing in the centre of the said concession in the Western limit of the said Lot; thence North seventy eight degrees thirty minutes East, Twelve chains seventy six links and a half more or less, to the centre of the said Lot; thence South eleven degrees thirty minutes East, fourteen chains fifty links more or less, to the North East limit of lands heretofore granted to John Burgess, in the said Lot; thence South, seventy eight degrees thirty minutes West, Ten chains; thence South eleven degrees thirty minutes East, Twenty five chains more or less, to the allowance for Road between the second and third concessions; thence South, seventy eight degrees thirty minutes West, Five chains seventy six links and a half more or less, to the limit between Lots, Numbers sixteen and seventeen; and thence North, eleven degrees thirty minutes West, thirty six chains fifty links more or less, to the place of beginning

To have and to hold the said Parcel or Tract of Land hereby granted, conveyed and assured, unto the said Aaron Springer, his heirs and assigns for ever; saving, excepting and reserving, nevertheless, unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Mines of Gold and Silver, and the free uses, passage and enjoyment of, in, over and upon all navigable waters that shall or may be hereafter found on or under, or be flowing through or upon any part of the said Parcel or Tract of Land hereby granted as aforesaid.

GIVEN under the Great Seal of Our Province of Canada: WITNESS, Our Right Trusty and Well-Beloved The Right Honorable SIR EDMUND WALKER HEAD, Baronet, one of Our Most Honorable Privy Council, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over Our Provinces of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and the Island of Prince Edward, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

At Toronto this Second day of June in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine and in the Twenty second year of Our Reign.
