I Michael Storer the Elder of the Township of
Norwich County of Oxford in the Brock District
and Province of Canada (West) Yeoman
Being of sound Mind Memory and under
standing do make this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following
(that is to say) First that I recommend my
Soul to God who gave it, and my body I com-
mit to the Earth, And as for and concerning
all of my worldly estat. I give, devise, bequeath
and dispose of as follows (that is to say,
I give and devise all and singular that contain
tract and parcels of land and premises, being
a part of the south half of Lot number eight in the
fourth concession in the said Township of Nor-
wich containing eighty Acres be the same more or
less and may be better known as follows (viz)
Commencing at the south west angle of the
said Lot number eight thence North Eleven degrees
and thirty minutes West thirty nine Chains
and fifty Links more or less to the centre of the
said concession, thence North seventy eight deg-
rees and thirty minutes East Ninety Chains
fifty three Links more or less to a point six chains
distant from the east side of said Lot thence South
Eleven degrees and thirty minutes East thirty chains
and sixty four chains more or less to a point eight chains
and sixty four Links distant from the west end of
the said fourth Concession thence south seventy
eight degrees and thirty minutes West twelve chains

and sixteen Links to where a post has been planted
thence South eleven degrees and thirty Minutes East
Eight Chains and eighty five Links more or less to
the rear end of the said conception, thence South
seventy eight degrees and thirty Minutes West seven
Chains and fifty four Links more or less to the place
of beginning. Together with all the Privileges and
appurtenances thereunto belonging unto my Son
Enoch Storer and to his Heirs and to their Heirs
for ever and in default of Issue from the said Enoch
Storer or that he die leaving no Heirs then the above
described premises I order my Executors to sell
and Deed the same and divide the proceeds of such
sale equally among all of my children and their
Heirs - I give and devise all and singular that
certain tract of Land and premises being a part
of the south half of Lot Number Nine in the said
fourth Conception of the Townships of Norwich
Containing twenty four Acres one Rood and
Eighteen square Rods the same that I am now
the rightful owner of together with all the Privi-
leges and appurtenances thereunto belonging
unto my Son Enoch Storer to his Heirs and
to their Heirs forever - In default of Issue or the
the said Enoch Storer leaving at his death no
Heirs the said Land and premises I order my
Executors to sell and Deed the same and to divide
the proceeds of such sale among all of my children
equally and their Heirs - I give to my Son Adam
Storer the sum of five Shillings and I wish it
particularly understood that in giving him
this small sum I have hitherto according

to his direction Decided to his Children one
 Hundred and Seventy five Acres of Land more
 or less being a part of Lot Number Eight in the
 Fifth Concession in the said Township of Norwich
 I further give to my son Adam Stone all of my
 Black Smiths Tools

I give and devise to my son Michael Stone the
 remaining part of the south half of Lot Number
 seven in the fourth Concession in said Township
 of Norwich which I have not Decided to him
 in before Reserving nevertheless to his Heirs and
 assigns forever Reserving nevertheless out of the
 North West Angle of said Lot Number seven ten
 Acres of the Timber in a square for the use of that
 part of Lot Number Eight devised to the said Enoch
 Stone and the Persons getting timber or Wood from
 said square shall keep up the fence in papering to
 and from said square

I give and devise all and singular that certain
 tract or parcels of Land and Premises known as
 Lot Number one in the Eighth Concession in said
 Township of Norwich supposed to contain two
 hundred Acres more or less together with all the
 privileges thereto belonging unto my son Adam
 Stone Michael Stone Enoch Stone and the Chil-
 -dren of my son George Stone (Deceased) (the said
 Children of my son George Stone are to receive one moiety
 Equale to one of my other sons named above) to
 their Heirs and assigns in equale proportion

And as to all of my Real Estate not named or disposed of in the above Bequest I hereby order and direct my Executors to dispose of the same in the most Judicious manner from time to time as opportunity may offer and divide the proceeds of such sale among all of my Children & their Heirs and assigns. I wish it particularly understood that any lands that I may have sold during my Lifetime or lands left by me for my Executors to sell whereby Deeds are required to be given for the conveyance of the same I hereby order and direct my Executors to give such Deeds which shall be valued -

And as to all of my Personal Estate of whatever kind or nature that remains after payment of all my just debts Funeral Charges and the proving of this my last Will and the expenses thence attending shall be equally divided among all of my Children without making sale thereof Reserving nevertheless out of the same my Cider Mill and the appurtenances belonging to the same for the purpose of making Cider and the Building in which the said Mill is erected shall remain as it now is for the use of my Children by their keeping the same in repair and the one that does not contribute his shall towards keeping the said Mill and said appurtenances in repair shall be excluded from the use of it

And I Will and direct further that in the

division of any property above named as being divided among my children - that the children ^{jointly} of my son George Storer Deceased shall receive a share of the same equally to what either of my other children receive

Lastly

I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Michael Storer my son in law John Nohu and Ephraim Cook Executors to this my Will and I do hereby revoke all former Wills at any time by me made and declare this only to be my last Will and Testament

In Witness whereof I the said Michael Storer the Testator have hereunto to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal this sixth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty nine.
