prays your Excellency will be pleased
to grant him Two hundred acres
of the waste lands of the Crown

 in open Court of General Quarter Sessions of the
 peace this day is recognized to be the son of
 Henry Swarts late of Blenheim aforesaid
 an enrolled M^cLoyalist deceased who retained
 his Loyalty during the late war with the United
 States of America without suspicion of aiding
 or assisting the enemy and that the said James
 Swarts was not then of age to do duty in defence
 of the Province
