certify that Pellum Teple of Oxford County
personally appeared in Open Court of
General Quarter Sessions of the Peace this
day is recognized by the Magistrates to be
the son of Peter Teple of Oxford aforesaid
Esquire an enrolled U.C. Loyalist who
retained his loyalty during the late war
with the United States of America without
suspicion of aiding or assisting the Enemy
and that the said Pellum Teple was
not then of age to do duty in defence of
the Province
