Sheweth

That your Petitioner in the Year 1816
prepared a Petition to His Excellency Governor Gore
for 200 Acres of Land paying fees under the
Regulations of that time, and on the 16th January
1816 an Order in Council passed directing Lot
921 in the T^h Concession of the Eastern Division of
the Township of before on the Thames to be reserved
for your Petitioner until further Order, in conse-
quence of his voluntary Services in the Militia,
and of the sufferings and Injuries he thereby
sustained, owing to the Incursions of the Enemy,
during the late War. That your Petitioner
has cleared and cultivated 25 Acres of said Lot & has
built two Houses and a Barn thereon, as appears
by the annexed Affidavit of two of the Neighbours

Wherefore your Petitioner humbly sub-
mits the annexed Certificate of his Services during
the late War, and Prays your Excellency will
be pleased to grant him a Patent for said Lot,
paying fees under the Regulations of the date
of the Order of His Excellency Governor Gore for
the insertion of his name thereon.
