913/ Lot No. 10 in 12<sup>th</sup> Concession of Blanchin is a Clog Reserve for which a Lease has not issued, but Isaac Alger appears to have paid the Patent Fee for our some years ago; he now transfers his claim as lessee (in which left he was viewed by the Clog Corporation) for the North half to the Petitioner, and for the South half to Whiting Kilborn. His recommendation that they be allowed to purchase, the former at 17/6, the latter at 16/3 per acre, each being in occupation of the respective parts with extensive improvements upon payment of the arrears of back-rent

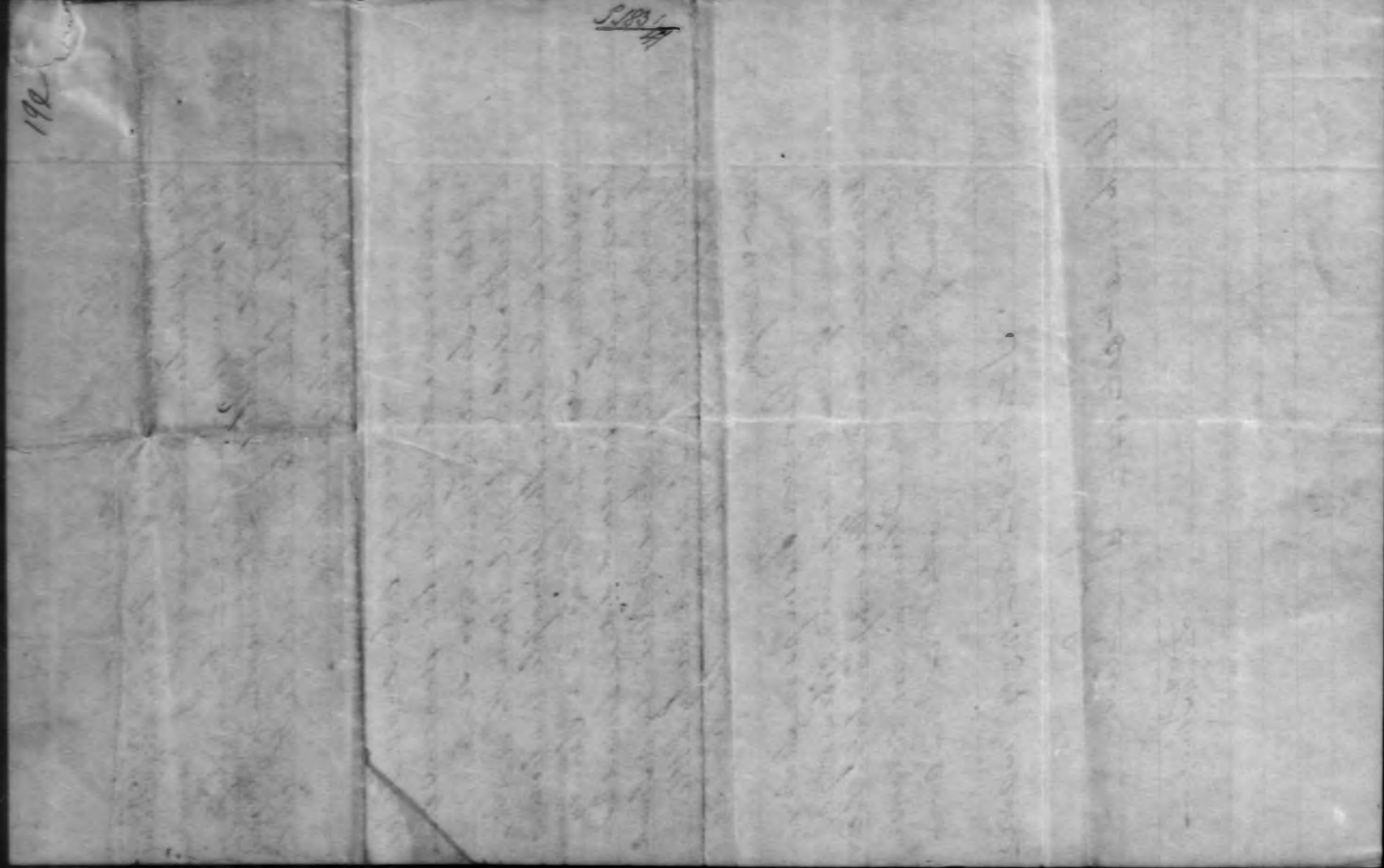
