in the County of Oxford Yeoman deceased who  
did intestate in the sum of one hundred pounds

previous of his real  
money of the Province of Louisiana for which  
present we bind ourselves and each  
of us to be paid to the said Charlotte  
Thompson, Clarke Thompson, Sarah Thompson  
and Maria Thompson and each of them  
or to his her and each of their certain attorney  
executors or administrators for which payment  
to be well and truly made we bind ourselves  
and each of us our heirs  
executors and administrators and every of  
them firmly by these presents sealed  
with our seals and dated this sixth day  
of January A D 1854

whereas the above named Daniel Wingarden  
appointed ~~guardian~~ <sup>has</sup> this day been  
appointed the guardian of the Person and property  
of the above named Charlotte Thompson, Clarke  
Thompson, Sarah Thompson and Maria Thompson  
the Infant Children of the said Thomas Thompson  
by William Dupont Esquire Judge of the  
Survival Court of the County of Oxford and  
the said Daniel Wingarden

has as they are required by law to do agreed to give  
surety to the said Infant Children aforesaid  
for the due discharge of such duties as guardian  
now the Condition after foregoing bond  
or obligation is such that if the said Daniel  
Wingarden do and shall faithfully  
perform the trusts imposed in ~~them~~ as such guardian  
and if the said Daniel Wingarden

do and shall when the said Infant  
Children shall respectively attain the age of twelve  
one years or whenever the said guardianship shall  
be determined or sooner if thereto required by the



Judge of the said Court reads to the said Infant  
Children aforesaid or to their or either of their  
executors or administrators a true and just  
account of all goods monies interest sent and  
profits or property of the said Infant Children  
in either of them which shall come into the hands  
of the said Daniel Wingard

and will thereupon without delay  
deliver and pay over to the said Infant Children  
respectively or to his or their respective  
executors or administrators the property or sum  
or balance of money which may be in the hands  
after said Daniel Wingard

belonging to the said Infant respectively  
or any of them deducible therefrom and retaining  
a reasonable sum for the expenses and charges of the  
said Infant respectively then the above written  
bond or obligation to be null and void  
signed sealed and delivered Daniel Wingard  
in the presence of Thomas Warfield
