and Dated at Woodstock in the County
of Oxford this third day of January in the year

Tibbitts deceased do make or cause to be made
a true and perfect inventory of all and singular
the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased
which have or shall come into the hands and
possession or knowledge of her the said Ellen
Tibbitts or into the hands and possession of
any other person or persons for her and the same

To make do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the
Registry of the ^{of the County of Essex} Vice-Chancery Court, on or before the first
Monday in June next ensuing and the same
goods chattels and credits of ~~Sydney Sibbitts deceased~~
and all other the goods chattels and credits of the said
deceased at the time of his death which at any time
after shall come into the hands or possession of the
said Ellen Sibbitts or into the hands and possession
of any other person or persons for her do well and
truly administer according to laws and further do
make or cause to be made a true and just account
of her said Administration at or before the first
of January A.D. 1686 and all the rest and value
of the said goods chattels and credits which shall
be found remaining upon the said Administration account
the same being first examined and allowed by the
Judge of the Court for the time being shall deliver
and pay unto such person or persons respectively
as the said Judge by his decree or sentence conformably
to the provisions in a certain act of Parliament Intituled
"An act for the better settling Intestate Estates and
passed in the twenty second and twenty third year of
the reign of Charles II and also in a certain act
passed in the first year of King James II. Contained
shall limit and appoints and if it shall hereafter
appear that any will or Testament was made by the
deceased and the Executors or Administrators thereof should
