and has taken the Oath of Allegiance. That being desirous
of obtaining a lease of the Reserve lot Number five
in the second concession of Wrentham aforesaid
for the purpose of improving and residing on the same
and for which he is prepared to pay the rent required
in advance by an order of Council.

Your petitioner therefore humbly
prays a lease of the said lot may be allowed him, and
in such case begs leave to name Elijah Mudge of
Wrentham aforesaid yeoman, as a security to be joined
in a Bond with your petitioner for the ~~the~~ performance
of the conditions wherein the said Lease may be granted
and as in duty bound your petitioner shall ever
pray - June 23. 1815
