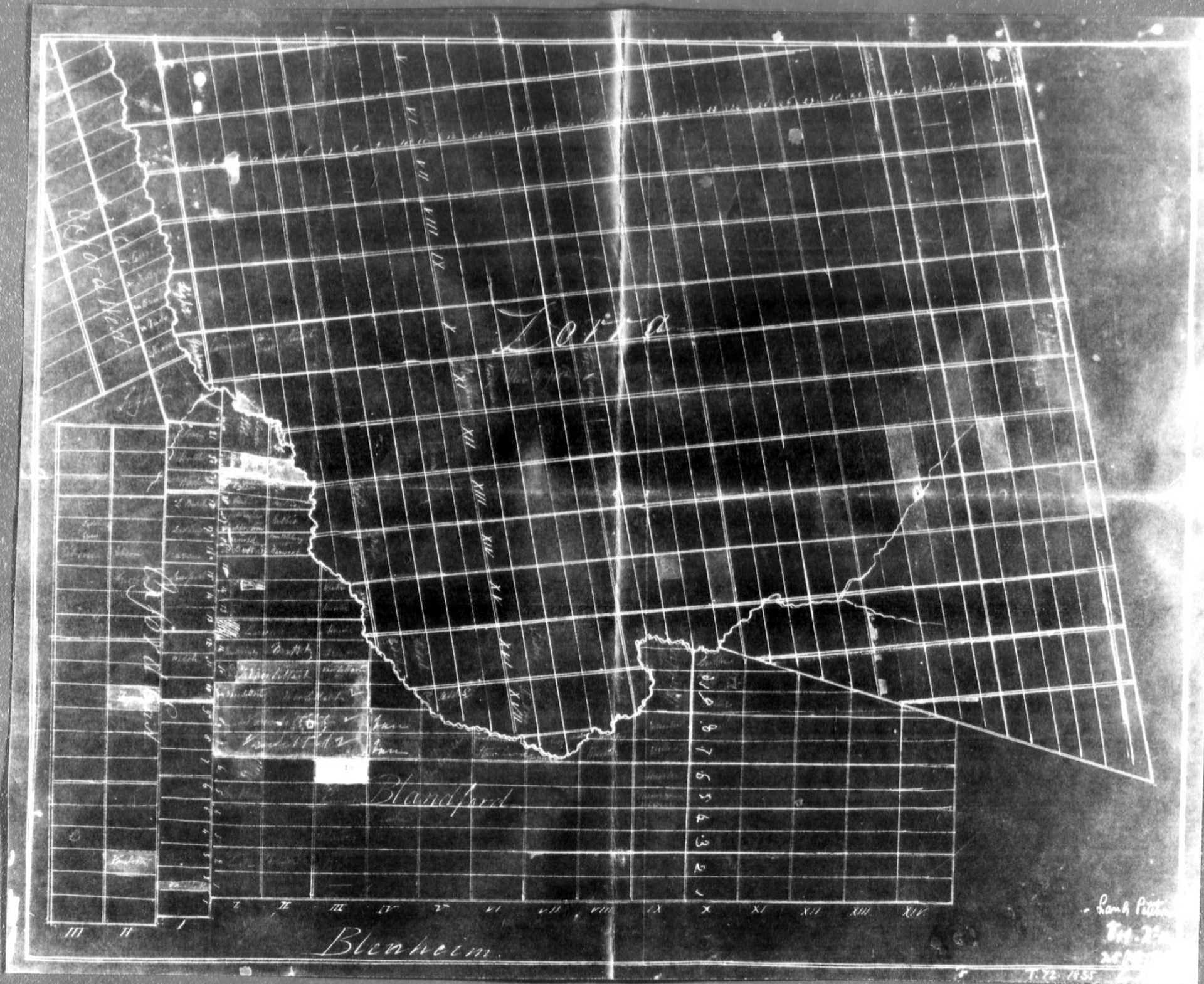

Sir

My Father W^m Adm^t Vaucliff having been allowed by an order in council of the 29th of Sept 1835 - to surrender to the Government for the use of the church, a certain house and land therein named to the value of £922.10 0⁰, and to receive as an equivalent, land at the upset price in the new township surveyed by Mr Hudson, West of Balsam Lake, and it having been recommended by the Comm: of Crown Lands on the 28th of October 1835, and by the Hon^{ble} Executive Council on the 5th of Nov^r, that I should submit a list of lots for that purpose to the Hon^{ble} Ex: Council. I beg now to state for the information of the L^t Governor, that my Father (W^m Adm^t) has since purchased the greater part of that township at public auction.

I beg therefore that ~~the~~ deeds for the following lots, purchased by him at the upset price of 5¹/₂ 0⁰ per acre may issue to him in lieu of the property surrendered. - V.S.L.
