The Humble Petition of Henry Van Pittart Esq. Admiral
Sheweth,

1st That in the year 1836 your Petitioner under the belief that the Government desired to increase the endowment to the Rectory of St. Asaph's, and for that purpose intended to sanction an Exchange of certain lands (being part of lot No. 21 and the whole of the broken lot No. 22 in the 2^d Concession Islandford on the River Thames the property of your Petitioner) for lot No. 8 in the 3^d Concession Islandford, did make a deed of the same to Government and duly registered the same.

2^d That your Petitioner from a minute in Council dated 26th Nov. 1836 has no reason to believe that the Exchange previously contemplated will be authorized, and therefore prays that the lands above mentioned the property of your Petitioner be restored. - The equivalent and the purpose for which they were surrendered not having been allowed -

3^d your Petitioner would suggest that as the said lands his property are in possession of Gov. that it would be equally acceptable to him to receive the said lot No. 8 as may be most convenient -
