Petitioner for Twelve hundred Acres of Land as One
of the Townships of the Township of Blenheim, in
which Township the same are located. Your Petitioner
has obtained the said Warrant, but from the date of
the said Order he is informed that his Grant must come
under the Regulations voted upon the 22nd December 1797
unless Your Excellency in Council is pleased to grant him
relief

Wherefore Your Petitioner prays that
Your Excellency may be pleased to Grant him the said
Twelve hundred Acres under the Regulations of the 6th
January 1796, acted upon the 9th July 1796 to put him on
a footing with other Townships
