Deed from Peter Carrall to Jeremiah Hughes and
Transferred by said Hughes to William Westcott
all the above described premises I give and bequeath to
my beloved Wife Catharine Westcott to have and to hold
to her and her heirs forever I give and bequeath

Hughes Executor of this my last will and Testam-
