That Sarah Williams late of the Township of Bruford in the District of Bruck
widow deceased departed this life on or about the fifth day of September in the year
of our Lord 1819. and by her last will and testament executed by her in the presence
of Thomas Buchanan and Robert Dunton. but which is without date, appointed
your petitioners to be the Executors of her said last will. That the deceased decedent
of divers goods and chattels profits and credits all within the said District amounting
to the whole as near as your petitioners have been enabled to ascertain to the sum of
Twenty pounds. That your petitioners are desirous of exhibiting the said will and taking
out probate thereof. Your petitioners therefore humbly pray your Honor will be
pleased to grant probate of the said will to them and your petitioners are
duly bound and ever pray.

The last Will and Testament of Sarah Williams, Widow of Lewis Williams, now deceased, residing in ^{the} Township of Burford, and on the eleventh Concession of the said Township, and in the Brock District.

This last Will and Testament witnesseth; that the said Sarah Williams doth leave and bequeath, after all debts are paid, which the said Sarah Williams now owes, that after all such sums are examined by the Executors namely: George Smith, and John Miles, and if found correct discharged by the said George Smith, and John Miles; that after the said Sarah Williams doth leave and bequeath to her only son Thomas Williams, the sum of ten shillings currency; and to her only daughter, Elizabeth Williams, all the remainder of money, goods, and chattels, of whatever kind.

The said Sarah Williams doth will and bequeath to her, the executors namely George Smith, and John Miles, to have power to collect all money, or notes of hand, from any person, or persons, who may be indebted to the said Sarah Williams; and also to have power, to rent any property, of whatever kind; namely; of landed property; until the period, at which time her only son shall attain the age of sixteen, or seventeen years; and also to have the care of her orphan children, namely Thomas Williams, and Elizabeth Williams, until such time as they are capable by law of taking care of themselves.
