called ~~Minigarden~~ of the township of Burford
in the County of Oxford in the Brock District of
the Province of Canada woman being sick of
body but of sound mind memory and
understanding and knowing that it is appointed
for all mankind to die Do make and ordain
this to be my last Will and Testament in manner
following (that is to say) firstly my desire is that my
body may be decently buried at the discretion of
my executors hereinafter named, and my soul
I commend to God who gave it - And as respects
such worldly goods as it has pleased God in his
infinite goodness to bestow upon me I give and
dispose of in manner following (that is to say) firstly I
give and bequeath to my dear wife Agnes one
Horse of Brown Horses - Harness wagon and Sleigh
three Cows of her choice & ten Sheep - also I give and
bequeath unto my dear wife All and singular
those certain Tracts or Parcels of Land and Premises
situate, lying, and being in the Township of Burford
~~opposite~~ containing by measurement one hundred
and twenty acres be the same more or less being the
south half of Lot Number three, and twenty acres off
of the first side of the south half of Lot number two
in the fourteenth concession of the said township of Burford
as long as she remains my widow - Then immediately
after her death or Marriage I give leave and
bequeath the said Lands and Premises unto my
two Daughters - Mariah and Lucinda, their heirs
and

and signs forever to be equally divided between them Mariah to have the last half and Luinda the first half after I give service and bequeath unto my said daughter ^{my heirs and} ~~Spouse~~ Luinda that certain tract or parcel of land and premises situated lying and being in the Township of Bowfords ~~six~~ containing by measurement ten acres being part of lot Number five in the fourteenth concession of the said township of Bowfords being the North part of eighty acres taken off the Westly side of said lot Number five, and the title derived from Elishim Malcolm of the township of Oaklands in said Ontario ~~Province~~ - also I give service and bequeath unto my said daughter Luinda her heirs and signs forever all and singular that certain tract or parcel of land and premises containing by measurement eleven acres being part of the above mentioned lot Number five in said fourteenth concession - and laying on the Eastly side of the above mentioned ten acres and adjoining the same - the title of which were also derived from the said Elishim Malcolm - I give service and bequeath unto my two brothers Jacob and Jacob their heirs and signs forever all and singular that certain tract or parcel of land and premises situated lying and being in the said township of Bowfords containing by measurement fifty acres be the same more or less - being the South East quarter of lot Number Nine in the fourteenth concession of the said township of Bowfords to be equally divided between them Jacob having the last part and Jacob the first - and as respects the rest revenue and remainder of my said estate of whatever

whatever nature or kind - to be sold at Public
auction - as soon as convenient after the close of
five months after my decease - and what money
remains after paying my Funeral expenses and
discharging all lawful debts to be expended for
the maintenance and education of my two
children - Provided nevertheless that in case
both my said daughters should die without -
leaving an Heir - Then and in that case I give
devise and Bequeath unto my Brothers Isaac
and Jacob their Heirs and assigns forever, the
above Tracts or Parcels of Land and Premises herein
before given devise and Bequeathed unto my
said Daughters - Isaac to have the parts given
to Isaac and Jacob the parts given to Zecunda,
I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint -
William Lemburner, and George Foster both of
the Township of Burford aforesaid Clerks
Executors of this my last will and testament -
hereby revoking all other and former wills by me
at any time theretofore made -
