Cornes Winegarden of the township of Burford  
in the County of Oxford in the Arch Diocese of  
the Province of Lancaſter Yeoman being sick of  
body but of sound mind memory and  
understanding and knowing that it is appointed  
for all mankind to die Do make and ordain  
this to be my last Will and Testament in manner  
following (that is to say) firstly my desire is that my  
body may be decently buried at the discretion of  
my Executors hereinafter named and my soul  
I commend to God who gave it - And as respects  
such worldly goods as it has pleased God in his  
infinite Goodness to bestow upon me I give and  
dispose of in manner following (that is to say) firstly I  
give and bequeath to my dear wife Agnes one  
Acre of Brown Horses - Harness Wagon and Sleigh -  
three Cows of her choice & ten Sheep - also I give and  
bequeath unto my last wife - All and singular  
those certain Tracts or Parcels of Land and Premises -  
situate lying and being in the Township of Burford  
aforesaid containing by admeasurement one hundred  
and twenty acres or thereabouts more or less being the  
south half of Lot Number three and twenty acres off  
of the West side of the south half of Lot Number two  
in the fourth Congregation of the said township of Burford  
as long as she remains my widow - Then immediately  
after her decease or Marriage I give devise and  
bequeath the said Land and Premises unto my  
two Daughters - Merick and Lucinda, their Heirs  
and

and Signs Forever. to be equally divided between  
them Mariah to have the East half and Luinda  
the West half. Also I Give devise and Bequeath  
unto my said daughter Mariah <sup>her heirs and Signs Forever</sup> all and singular  
that certain tract or Parcel of Land and Premises  
situate lying and being in the Township of Burford  
aforesaid containing by admeasurement ten acres being  
part of Lot Number five in the fourth conception of  
the said township of Burford, being the North parts  
of eighty acres taken off the West side of said Lot  
Number five, and the little parcel from William  
Malcolm of the township of Oakland in said District  
Cognac - Also I Give devise and bequeath unto my  
said daughter Luinda her Heirs and Signs forever  
all and singular that certain tract or Parcel of Land
