The Condition of this obligation is such, that if the above named *Isabella Winter* the administratrix of all the personal estate and effects, rights and credits of *Mathew Winter* late of the *Township of Pelsham* in the County of *Oxford* *Upper Canada* deceased, (who died on the *fourteenth* day of *February* A.
