Province in the year 1799. I served
through the war of 1812 as my papers
in the Land Office will show I
made application August 1835
at the Land Office to locate Lot
No Eight in the Seventh Concession
of Oxford (E. D.) and district of
Brock I received verbal encourage-
ment with an order to get a deputy
Surveyor whose report went
to show that no improvement
was made previous 1835 and as
I am a Land Claimant and have
a claim on the said Lot by the
Report of the Inspector of Crown
