## HARRIS FAMILY HISTORY

Eli Harris and his wife Lucretia (Ransom) came to Oxford County in 1802 from New York state, they being Loyalists. They may have been from Otsego County. On the 1812 agricultural assessment for Oxford, Eli Harris was the assessor. Elis Harris died 1813 (see Baptists Work in Oxford)

Eli Harris and Lucretia Harris had eleven children - 8 sons and three daughters. Six of the sons became ministers ( not all Baptists) -see Early Days of Baptists in Oxford by Zella Hotson.
